I, \_\_\_\_\_ agree to and accept the following terms and conditions in regard to the temporary foster care of Doberman Pinschers placed in my care through Houston Area Doberman Rescue (HADR).

In fostering a Doberman for Houston Area Doberman Rescue, Inc., I agree to the following:

1. I am not authorized to keep any foster Doberman placed with me, or to give, sell, transfer or adopt any foster Doberman to another individual, rescue group, shelter or boarding facility except under the direction of a **current HADR Board Member or Adoption Coordinator**.
2. **All foster Dobermans are the property of Houston Area Doberman Rescue, Inc. until they have been adopted and an approved adoption contract executed.**
3. I will immediately report any temperament, behavior or health changes/problems to:

4. Any and all medical care, unless deemed an immediate medical emergency, must be authorized by a board member prior to administration. In the event of a medical emergency, the Doberman may be taken directly to a veterinarian. I am authorized only to seek minimal stabilization of a Doberman as needed to sustain life. I will contact a board member immediately for further treatment authorization. I understand that HADR is a non-profit organization; as such, there may not be funds available to treat the above-described Doberman, and that euthanasia may be deemed necessary. Furthermore, I understand that HADR has working relationships with several veterinarians and, for financial reasons, may choose to transfer the care of the Doberman to another veterinarian.
5. I will keep the health, safety and well-being of a Doberman under my care, a priority at all times while it is in my care. I will provide it adequate food, water and shelter at all times as well as maintain grooming (nail trims and bathing), when necessary. I will follow all instructions given to me in regard to medications, feeding and training. The Doberman will be kept inside my home but provided with adequate time to eliminate and exercise in a controlled environment (on lead, fenced-in yard, etc). It will be maintained on a leash when outside my property at all times and will not be allowed to ride in the open bed of a pick-up under any circumstances. This Doberman will be kept inside my home at night. I will not place this Doberman in a situation that may cause harm to the above-described Doberman, other humans or animals that it may come in contact with.
6. I understand this animal is a rescue Doberman. As such, there are no guarantees given or implied in regard to his health, condition, communicable diseases, or temperament. HADR and its members will not be held liable for any damages or injuries by the Doberman to property, animals or persons including, but not limited to, injury or death.
7. I agree to keep my personal dogs up to date on all vaccinations. HADR strongly recommends that my dogs have Rabies and DHLPP-PC boosters as required by state or local laws and/or my veterinarian. Intranasal Bordetella is recommended every six (6) months. Heartworm and flea prevention are highly recommended to prevent any transfer of intestinal parasites, fleas and/or ticks possibly harbored by rescued Dobermans.

8. I understand the purpose of Doberman rescue is to rehabilitate the animal and place it in a permanent home. HADR attempts to only place Dobermans that are deemed to be temperamentally sound and physically healthy. If HADR deems this Doberman to be unsound or not placeable while under my foster care, it must be returned to HADR immediately for evaluation.
9. As a foster home for HADR, I will make every effort to ensure that the reputation of the organization, the practices of animal rescue and the Doberman Pinscher breed will be viewed in a positive regard at all times. If I do not have answers for individuals that may inquire about the rescue program, the Doberman I am fostering or Dobermans in general, I understand that I may refer them to speak with any member of the Board of Directors.
10. If I borrow any equipment (noted below) from HADR or its volunteers, I will maintain it in the condition it was loaned to me.

11. If I have been provided with any food or medications, I understand they are to be used only for HADR Dobermans under my care.
12. I agree to transport any HADR Doberman under my foster care, as directed by HADR, for medical treatment or to meet a potential adopter.
13. I agree to provide HADR access to the foster Doberman in my home or at an agreed location when requested by an HADR Board Member or the Adoption Coordinator.
14. HADR does not condone the intentional or accidental reproduction (breeding) of rescued Dobermans. If this Doberman has not been spayed or neutered prior to my taking possession of it, I will ensure that it will NOT be allowed to reproduce. Bitches in season will be kept away from intact male dogs at all times. Intact male Dobermans will be kept away from intact females at all times. Furthermore, I will ensure that intact male or female dogs will be contained in enclosures sufficient to prevent escape or entrance of other dogs at all times.
15. I will communicate the overall health status or other issues such as behavioral problems of the fostered Doberman on a regular basis to the group or upon request by a Board Member. Timely communications are critical in keeping the Doberman healthy and alerting us of any problems.
